Bond Street Tube station is undergoing a £300m upgrade, forming part of wider significant changes to the central London Underground service.

The prestigious contract, due to be completed in 2017, was awarded to Costain Laing O'Rourke Joint Venture, with ASSA ABLOY Security Doors' products specified by Halcrow Atkins. Seeing the incorporation of a new Crossrail station, the improvement works will help to service more than 225,000 passengers per day.
